Call Before You Climb Procedure

The follow procedure applies where unoccupied towers exist within 400m of an ECCC S-Band Weather Radar. The 400m range limit was applied to ensure persons climbing towers maintain exposure levels below the 'controlled environment' limits set out by Health Canada's SC6 standard.

DO NOT RETURN RADAR TO FULL **COVERAGE** until confirmation is received that no workers are on the nearby tower.
