## VO1BT Call Before You Climb Procedure

The following procedure applies where unoccupied towers exist within 400m of an ECCC S-Band Weather Radar. The 400m range limit was applied to ensure persons climbing towers maintain exposure levels below the 'controlled environment' limits set out by Health Canada's SC6 standard.

Step 1: Schedule activity with ECCC (24hr MIN notice, 2wks MAX notice)

<b>Step 2:</b> Upon arrival to tower site, contact ECCC to confirm activity	
<ul> <li>Contact 416-739-4555 and confirm the following information:         <ul> <li>Coordinates of tower being serviced</li> <li>Required timing of climbing (±30min)</li> <li>Confirm duration of work at height on tower Contact information for technicians on-site</li> </ul> </li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Initiate safe shutdown of Weather Radar transmitter in direction of tower being climbed</li> <li>Update NRIS</li> <li>Open NMD Ticket</li> </ul>
Step 3: Standby-by for call back from ECCC Radar Operations	
<ul> <li>DO NOT CLIMB TOWER until 'safe to climb' condition is confirmed via phone call by ECCC Radar Operations</li> <li>A personal RF monitor (Narda RadMan XT or equivalent) is required.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Call contact provided in <u>Step 2</u> to confirm radar has been configured for safe climbing of requested tower.</li> <li>Update NRIS</li> </ul>
Step 4: Upon completion of Climbing act	tivity, notify ECCC
<ul> <li>Contact 416-739-4555 and confirm no workers are on the tower and that no further climbing will occur.</li> <li>If work will continue the following day, notify ECCC during <u>Step 4</u> and resume procedure at <u>Step 2</u> the following day.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Log time of activity completion and name of confirming party. Initiate return of full radar coverage.</li> <li>Update NRIS, close NMD ticket</li> <li>If no call back is received for 60min after expected completion of climbing work, call contact provided in <u>Step 2</u>.</li> </ul>
	<b>O DO NOT RETURN RADAR TO FULL</b>
When calling the Badar Operations botline (416-739	<b>COVERAGE</b> until confirmation is received that no workers are on the nearby tower.
